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Graduate Admission Standards

Although the student advising program at Murray State-Union is the responsibility of all students through degree programs, it is the responsibility of all students to that apply to their programs of study.

Admission standards for graduate programs at Murray State-Union are as follows:

- For the Master of Arts (M.A.) and Master of Science (M.S.) degrees, a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 is required.
- For the Master of Education (M.Ed.) degree, a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 is required.
- For the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) degree, a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 is required.

Admission Processes

The admission process for graduate programs at Murray State-Union involves several steps:

- Application: Students must complete the Graduate Application Form and submit it to the Office of Graduate Admissions.
- Transcripts: Students must submit official transcripts from all institutions attended.
- Test Scores: Some programs may require GRE or GMAT scores.
- Interview: Some programs may require an interview with the faculty advisor.
- Admission Decision: The Office of Graduate Admissions will review all materials and make an admission decision.

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
